### **Implementation of Examination Reforms**

The office of Examination in charge has taken several initiatives to ensure fair and transparent Examination.

All precautions are being taken to minimize any error during paper-setting, moderation and printing of question papers of internal examination, conduct of examination, uploading of marks on ERP, award lists, result processing and declaration. High level of confidentiality is maintained during the entire examination process.

1. Each theory paper will be of 100 marks. At the end of the semester external examination will be conducted by the University with Max. Marks 75. The Internal / Sessional examination will carry Max. Marks 25.
2. Internal / Sessional marks shall be awarded on the basis of internal tests, quizzes, class assignments, seminars, etc. Out of 25 marks for internal Assessments, 15 marks shall be for two recorded internal tests and 10 marks for quizzes, class assignments etc.
3. The minimum passing marks in each Paper / Viva-voce / Practical shall be 40% of the total marks of internal Assessment and external Examination taken together. The Minimum passing marks in aggregate shall be 50%marks in each semester.
4. The paper on “Environmental Studies” shall be of qualifying nature and will be governed by the rules of University. This paper will be a part of first Semester curriculum. This paper will have Max. Marks 100 and 33 as minimum passing marks.
5. Practical Examination/ Viva voce examination would be conducted by a panel of examiners to be appointed by the University as per university norms.
6. The rules and regulations for the conduct of the End-Semester University Examinations and the Practical Examinations would be the same as prescribed by the University for other UG Examinations.
7. If a candidate fails in a course and re-appears in Back papers/ Ex-student to clear that course, the Internal Assessment awards would remain the same as he/she obtained in the first attempt.
8. A student has o put in a minimum 75% attendance in a paper / course concerned as per university rules.
9. Re-evaluation/Challenge evaluation of answer sheet and scrutiny will be as per the university rules.
10. If a candidate is found using unfair means in any paper, he/she would be governed by rules of the University in the regard.
