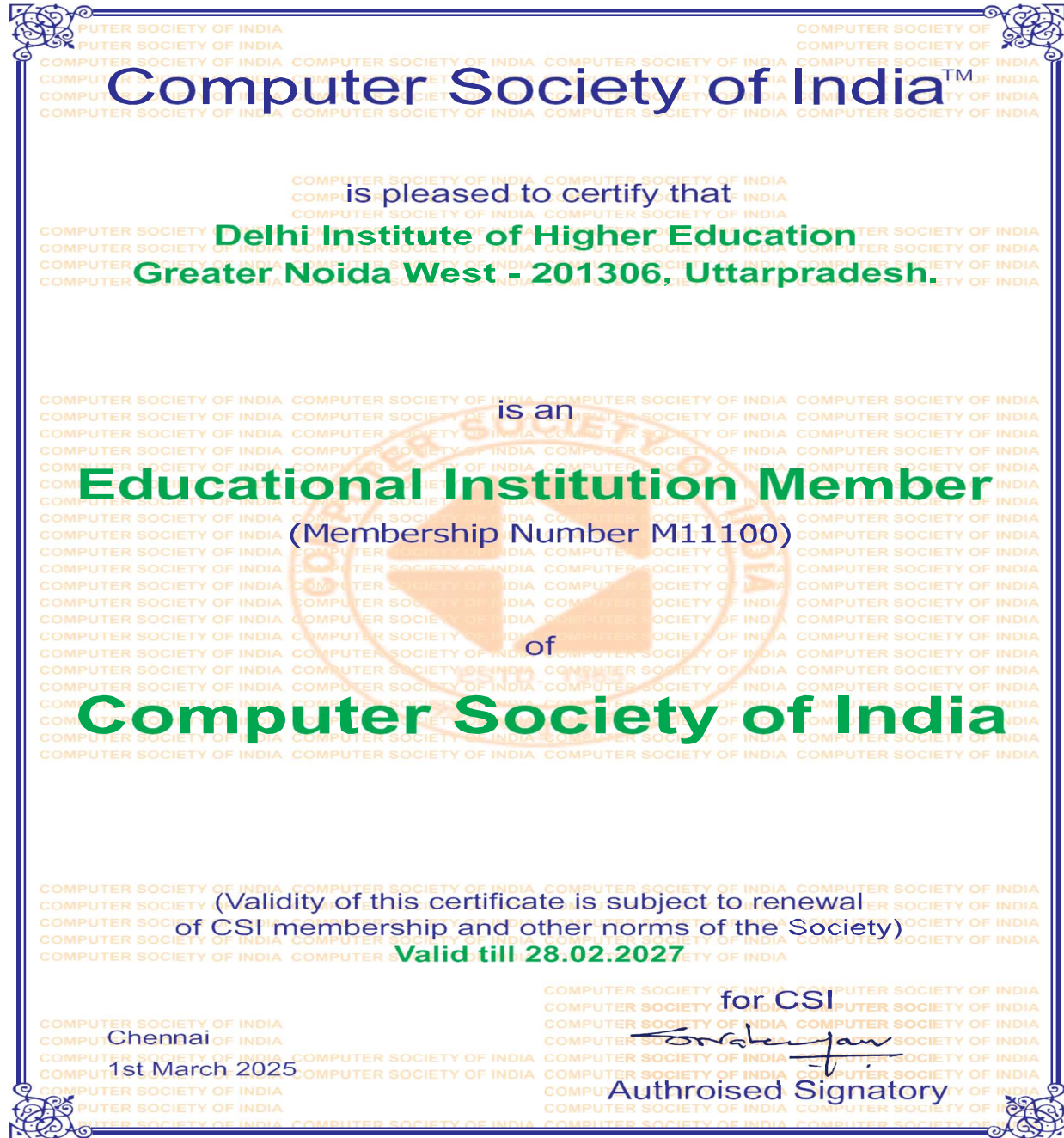

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") is entered into as of 12-Apr-2024, (the "Effective Date"), by and between **CSharp Inc.**, located at Kirk Road, Garnet Valley, PA (USA), hereinafter referred to as "**CSharp**," and **Delhi Institute of Higher Education**, Plot no 20 C, Tech Zone IV, Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh 201308, hereinafter referred to as the "**College**."

WHEREAS, CSharp is an American company focusing in technology, education, mentorship, career and startup guidance services to colleges and universities and is the owner of several online properties including C# Corner, one of the largest community of software professionals with 30 million annual users; and

WHEREAS, the College seeks to enhance its educational offerings by providing hackathons and Web 3.0/full stack/cutting edge technologies training to its students;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

Scope of Collaboration:

- a) CSharp agrees to provide hackathons and online training about the latest technologies to the College's students.
- b) The College agrees to encourage and help its students take part in the hackathons and online training sessions organized by CSharp.

Duration:

This MOU shall be in effect for a period of one year, commencing on the Effective Date, unless terminated earlier by mutual agreement or as provided in this MOU.

Responsibilities of CSharp:

- a) CSharp shall develop and deliver hackathons and training sessions on cutting edge technologies to the College.
- b) CSharp shall assign experienced trainers/mentor and facilitators to conduct the hackathons and online training sessions.
- c) CSharp shall provide necessary technical resources, materials, and support for the successful execution of the hackathons and online training sessions.
- d) No Financial amount is involved for any activity under this program.

Responsibilities of the College:

- a) The College will provide student ambassadors (2 to 4) to assist CSharp. These ambassadors will help with organizing and conducting the hackathons and online training sessions.

- b) The College will support its student ambassadors in arranging a yearly CSharp conference at the college.
- c) The College will help its student ambassadors coordinate logistical aspects of the hackathons and training sessions, such as booking venues, setting schedules, and registering students.
- d) The College will provide the necessary facilities, equipment, and internet access to support the smooth running of the hackathons and training sessions for CSharp through its student ambassadors.
- e) No Financial amount is involved for any activity under this program.

Intellectual Property:

- a) Each Party shall retain ownership of their respective pre-existing intellectual property.
- b) Any intellectual property developed during the hackathons and training sessions shall be owned by CSharp.

Confidentiality:

Both Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any confidential information disclosed during the course of this collaboration and not to disclose such information to any third party without the prior written consent of the disclosing Party.

Termination:

Either Party may terminate this MOU by providing a written notice of termination to the other Party at least three months prior to the intended termination date.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction:

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of U.P., without regard to its conflict of laws principles. Any disputes arising out of or in connection with this MOU shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in India, U.P.

Entire Agreement:

This MOU constitutes the entire understanding and agreement between the Parties concerning the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior negotiations, understandings, and agreements, whether oral or written, relating to the same.

Hereinafter individually referred to as CII or DIHE, as it may be, and collectively referred to as the Parties.

WHEREAS:



WHEREAS:



ARTICLE IX: Miscellaneous

- i) This MOU can only be amended in writing by mutual consent of both the Parties.
 - ii) This MOU shall come in effect from the date of affixing signature by both the Parties and shall remain valid for a period of Three (03) year from that date, subject to any written notice by one party to the other party, expressing its intent to terminate this MOU.
 - iii) Either of the Parties, may terminate this MOU by way of 2 (two) months advance notice. In such an event, both the Parties, shall make all endeavours to fulfil their obligations and responsibilities for any ongoing program(s), project(s) or any endeavour(s) which has been initiated under this MOU.
 - iv) This MOU may be executed in counterparts including but not limited to MOUs, communications exchanged defining responsibilities, obligations of both the Parties for different programmes, initiatives etc. under this MOU, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, and all of which, taken together, shall constitute an integral part of this MOU.
 - v) If any provision of this MOU shall be invalid, illegal or otherwise unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall in no way be affected or impaired thereby.
 - vi) The captions of the clauses of this MOU are for convenience of reference only and in no way define, limit or affect the scope or substance of any clause of this MOU.

ARTICLE V: Confidentiality

For the purposes of this MOU:

- i) either of the Parties who provides any sensitive or commercial information shall be referred to as '**Disclosing Party**' and
 - ii) either of the Parties, receiving such information shall be referred to as '**Recipient Party**'. The Recipient Party shall use the confidential information of the provided by the Disclosing Party solely in accordance with the provisions of this MOU and will not disclose or permit to be disclosed, the same, directly or indirectly, to any third party without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent.
- The Recipient Party shall exercise all care and caution in protecting the confidential information provided by the Disclosing Party, from any unauthorized use and disclosure. However, neither party bears any responsibility for safeguarding information which:
- i) is publicly available,
 - ii) obtained by the other party from third parties without restrictions on disclosure,
 - iii) independently developed by the other party without reference to confidential information, or
 - iv) required to be disclosed by order of a court or other law enforcement entity, provided written notice of such compelled disclosure before court or law enforcement entity is intimated to the Disclosing Party.

ARTICLE VI: Indemnity

The Delhi Institute of higher Education (DIHE) agrees to indemnify and hold harmless CII, its officers, employees and agents from all claims, liabilities and losses to the extent based on gross negligent acts or gross negligent omissions of the Delhi Institute of higher Education (DIHE), its officers, employees, and agents in the performance of this Agreement.

ARTICLE VII: Force Majeure

If performance of this MoU or any obligation under this MoU is prevented, restricted, or interfered with by causes beyond either party's reasonable control ("Force Majeure"), and if the party unable to carry out its obligations gives the other party prompt written notice of such event, then the obligation of the party invoking this provision shall be suspended to the extent necessary by such event. The term Force Majeure shall include without limitation, acts of God, fire, explosion, vandalism, storm or other similar occurrences, orders or acts of military or civil authority, or by national emergencies, insurrections, riots, or wars, or strikes, lock-outs, work stoppages or a pandemic. The excused party shall use reasonable efforts under the circumstances to avoid or remove such causes of non-performance and shall proceed to perform with reasonable dispatch whenever such causes are removed or ceased. An act or omission shall be deemed with the reasonable control of a party if committed, omitted, or caused by such party, or its employees, officers, agents, or affiliates.

ARTICLE VIII: Governing Law, Jurisdiction & Arbitration

- i) This MOU shall be construed, interpreted and enforced in accordance with Laws of India.
- ii) In case of any differences, both the parties, shall make all efforts to settle the disputes amicably through mutual discussion and negotiation, failing which, dispute(s) shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator appointed by both the Parties, as per provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including. Language of Arbitration shall be English and place of Arbitration shall be New Delhi, India.
- iii) Subject to the Arbitration Clause, the Courts competent jurisdiction at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction in respect of any and all matters pertaining to this MOU.
